

## Embedding YouTube Videos into your School Website

This guide is for videos that have already been posted on YouTube. For this you need to create a YouTube account and upload your videos to YouTube.

To embed YouTube videos, you need to have two internet windows/tabs open:

1. Your website administration page
2. Your YouTube video page

### In your Website Administration:

1. Click **Pages**
2. Click **Content**
3. Select the page that you want the video on
4. Uncheck the **turn WYSIWYG on/off**

1. Click **Embed** to get the video embed code



This will open a code section similar to the one below:



2. Ensure all of the code is **highlighted**
3. **Copy** (right click, then copy)

## Back in your Website Administration:

In your web screen area, ensure that you are on a new line

1. **Paste** the code
2. Click **Submit**
3. View your website to ensure that your video has embedded correctly.
