

Uploading a Video File onto YouTube

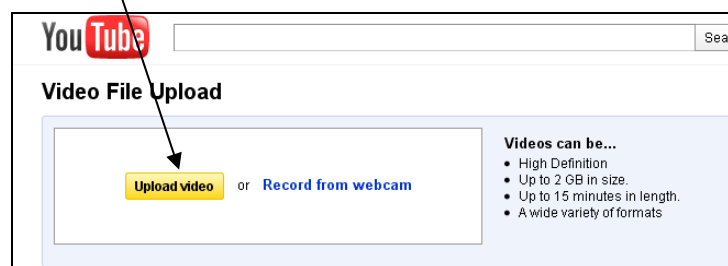
To upload a video file onto YouTube, you need to have created a YouTube account and be signed in to your account.

Uploading the Video File

1. Click **Upload**



2. Click **Upload Video**



3. Select your video file from your local computer
4. Click **Open**

Your video will begin to upload

Once your video file has uploaded, you can fill in the video information and privacy settings section.

If you select the **Unlisted Privacy** option, only people that you direct to the link can view your video.

You will also be given the link/address in which your video is live.
